Georgia – Cradle of Wine

I travel to Georgia every year. Georgia is my favourite escape of reality. The wine, nature, food and hospitality are things that interest me in the highest way. A few years ago I was invited to present the European Wine Market on the VinExpo Wine Fair in Tbilisi, Georgia. That is where I visited the country for the first time, unknowing I would become an ambassador.

Georgia is widely regarded as the birthplace of wine. We should be thankful to them.

Through years of visiting Georgia annually I slowly began to understand its wine traditions, its grapes and its love for their products.

These are the bottles that, to me, best capture the soul of Georgian wine. Georgia did not just teach me about wine. It changed the way I look at it.

Kakhetia | Koncho Family Wines | Kisi Semi-Sweet | 2022 BIO   35

Kisi

Crafted by the Koncho family in Georgia's Kakheti region, this semi-sweet Kisi offers ripe peach, apricot and floral aromas. Its natural sweetness is beautifully balanced by fresh acidity and freshness.

Kakhetia | Château Buera Rkatsiteli Reserve | 2019  55

Rkatsiteli

Château Buera combines modern winemaking with the start of Georgian wine tourism. This Reserve Rkatsiteli delivers ripe orchard fruit, subtle buttery richness and gentle oak influence.

Orange

Kakhetia | Casreli Wines | Erekle | 2021 BIO   46

Rkatsiteli, Kisi, Mtsvane, Khikhvi

Created by five Georgian doctors who turned their shared passion into a natural wine project, Erekle blends Rkatsiteli, Kisi, Mtsvane and Khikhvi. Expect dried mango, bergamot, orange zest and elegant tea-like tannins.

Kakhetia | Papari Valley | Rkatsiteli-Chinuri 3 Terraces | 2022 BIO   48

Rkatsiteli, Chinuri

Sourced from three hillside terraces, this qvevri-fermented Rkatsiteli is layered and complex. Expect dried apricot, orange peel, chamomile and walnut, supported by vibrant acidity, delicate tannins and a long, savoury finish.

Saperavi

Once our house wine, Koncho Saperavi is the perfect introduction to Georgia's flagship grape. It offers dark berries, plum, gentle spice and smooth tannins with outstanding drinkability.

Kakhetia | Château Buera Saperavi Reserve | 2019  55

Saperavi

This place is a little piece of heaven in Georgia, most beautiful winery I have ever visited. The wine is robust, complex and dark. The fruit of blackberries and berries effortlessly masters the wood aging.

Kakhetia | Papari Valley | Qvevri 5 Saperavi | 2023  49

Saperavi

Papari Valley Qvevri 5 is intensely concentrated—so dark you could write a letter with it. Layers of black fruit, liquorice root, bay leaf and earthy spices are lifted by vibrant acidity and powerful, refined tannins.

Kartli | Kapistoni | Shavkapito Qvevri | 2022 BIO  48

Shavkapito

From the Kartli region in central Georgia, Kapistoni showcases the indigenous Shavkapito grape. A lighter alternative to Saperavi, it offers smoky notes, red berries, freshness and just a hint of fine qvevri tannins.

Full bodied Champagne, dominated by the Pinot Meunier grape. We prefer to serve it in Burgundy glasses to open its full potential. This Champagne can be easily paired with your fish menu or even poultry.

Chardonnay

Her name, Vikka, means "traveler, adventurer" in Old Norse. It was chosen as a tribute to the family's Scandinavian roots, which certainly play a role in their tribal spirit and their taste for exploration. This 2009 Blanc de Vins, after 12 months of disgorging, was submerged 60 meters below sea level in the most extreme corner of France, near the island of Ouessant. In this place, battered by waves and wind, an almost mystical symbiosis takes place between the seabed and the chalky Champagne terroir.

Ripe champagne who balances great complexity with beautiful freshness for lovers of Brioche Champagne.

Every year Bollinger introduces an ode to Pinot Noir. Quinten was invited to the unforgettable introduction of this vintage. The 2019 comes mainly from Pinot Noir from Verzenay. It is a lush symphony in which all the aromas melt together in a silky long finish.

Fresh and precise at first, before opening into layers of toasted almonds, butter and remarkable length.

Absolute top cuvee. Soft mousse with an enormously long mature finish. A gastronomic champagne that belongs at the table, not just in the glass.

Shiraz

An Australian icon made with museum vintages dating back to the 60's. This is the history of Australian wine in a bottle. They handcraft the Sparkling Red using a unique blend of aged Australian reds from the past fifty years. The result is a brooding, opulent wine with aromas of leather, spice, cedar, and a smooth, velvety finish.

One of my favourites. Oyster shells over a quince and roasted apple background. Perfect companion of your seafood.

Barrel fermented Verdejo, so slightly creamier than you would expect. Carrasviñas is the winery of the king of Verdejo, Felix Lorenzo Cachazo who deserved the "DO Rueda" for verdejo wines.

Viura (80%), Calagraño, Malvasia, Maturana Blanca, Garnacha Blanca
This is what white Rioja is all about. Old Bush Vine Rioja Blanco with incredible energy. Oxer proves Rioja can be every bit as exciting in white as it is in red

Rioja | Cuna de Maras | Elharkano | 2018 BIO **NEW** 79
Izkiriota Txikia, Petit Manseng, Malvasia, Pinot Grigio, Viognier, Viura
With the help of a Belgian importer, I discovered this tiny winery in Rioja. They craft wines in an extremely creative way, where everything is handcrafted and meticulously executed. This is a seriously underrated showcase of white Rioja. I've never tasted them like this before.

Penedès | ELECTIO | Parés Baltà | 2021 BIO   85
Xarel-Lo
Only ninety-year-old Xarello vines could create this much texture and concentration. This is a wine that displays my wine list. I brought this wine to every wine list I made in every restaurant where I worked.

Galicia | Rías Baixas | Zarate | "Sal da Terra" | 2024   74
Albariño
"Sal da Terra", The Salt of the Earth, a seductive Albariño with a complex nose of blossom, ripe stone fruit, citrus, almond, and seaweed. The palate is quite full-bodied, yet beautifully balanced with soft acidity and a long, salty finish.

Albariño **Only in Magnum 150cl**
I was at Xuxo's winery in July 2026. He asked me if I wanted to sell these bottles back to him. This says enough about the wine and that 2017 vintage.

Godello **Magnum 150cl (2023)** 95
Nice combination of citrus and yellow fruit in the nose, light wood touch, filming in the mouth, spicy, slightly salty, elegant and complex. You can see why Rafael is the Godello King.

Godello
One of Spain's greatest wines, with that little "Zeeland" touch.

This wine is better than a backheel assist to Aguero for Manchester City. Pronounced saltiness in the aroma with a light smoky touch. Fresh lime, grapefruit and nice saltiness to accompany your seafood.

After a Portugal trip I was surprised by the quality of an unknown grape, Encruzado. Taste it and you will find lovely citrus acidity interwoven with refined hints of hazelnut and vanilla. A sunshine wine.

Field Blend
Old vine field blend with striking minerality and nuances of flint and barrel ageing. Greasiness and a long aftertaste will improve your seafood or fish dish. Really surprising wine.

Pinot Noir

Red wine from the suburbs of northern Niigata. Light red and initially slightly sulphurous on the nose. It has fresh berry fruit, raspberry, and wild strawberry notes.
